

JASON PARISH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

GENERAL CRITERIA

Scholarship will be awarded to applicants who best combine the qualifications set forth hereunder. The number of scholarships and the amount given each year will be determined by the selection committee.

ELIGIBILITY

All scholarship candidates must be in their graduating year of high school or have already graduated from high school at the time of application.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Present or former member of the Simon Fraser Region (BCSSA)
2. C+ average or better in the candidates last year of high school (in order to equalize all candidates, regardless of their current academic status)
3. Community involvement - community is not necessarily restricted to the aquatic community, and diversity of involvement is looked upon very favourably. Activities that are interpreted as being part of the requirements of a 'job-track' are weighted to a much lesser degree. Letters of support are encouraged.

SELECTION

Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee comprised of a designate of the Parish family, a Simon Fraser Region representative and a representative of Leisure Services of Coquitlam or Port Coquitlam or Port Moody or Burnaby. The committee will short-list the applications and submit up to three applications **without** the names of the applicants to the Parish family for a final decision.
