Saturday, May 31, 2008 & Sunday, June 1, 2008



- Meet Manager:** Diane Kamagianis (604-351-0939) dkamagia@shaw.ca
- Location:** Mission Leisure Centre, 7650 Grand St. (Grand & 7th Ave.)
Entrance is opposite the high school. The pool is a 6 lane, 25 meter facility. A food concession is on site as well as a sports shop, which sells a limited supply of swim gear. The water park will be open, weather permitting.
- Type of Meet:** "Open" Meet format (no A/ B cutoff); timed finals; competitors may enter a maximum of 6 individual events and 2 relays (including 6 & Under swimmers who may swim 6 & Under events and/or division 1 events but may only enter a total of 6 individual events).
Meet Registrars: please ensure that swimmers in Div 5 and higher register for only six (6) of the seven (7) available individual events. Heats will be run from slowest to fastest so it is important that the swimmers are registered with their fastest times. Please make every effort to time all swimmers who do not possess official times. As a last resort estimate the swimmers times. **NOTE:** please ensure that all swimmers have been placed in their proper Division by BCSSA.

Please include a validation list. **Entries must be made by Monday, May 26, 2008 at 8:00 p.m.** Deck entries and late entries can be made up until 7:15 a.m. the morning of the event providing there is space. There will be a \$5.00 charge per entry for any deck or late entries. Deck and late entries will be placed in available spaces and slow heats if there is room.

- Times:** Warm-ups: 6:45 a.m. - 7:45 a.m. (Club lanes will be posted at the pool)
Scratches & Deck Entries: 7:15 a.m.
Officials Meeting: 7:30 a.m.
Marshalling: 8:00 a.m.
Coaches Meeting: 7:45 a.m.
Meet Begins: 8:15 a.m.
Relays Due: 10:00 a.m. (no exceptions)
- Entry Fees:** The Fraser Valley Region Clubs have a Reciprocal agreement.
- Late Fee:** **\$5.00 per entry will be charged for any late entries or deck entries.** These swimmers must be entered by 7:15 a.m. on the day of the event however they will only be accepted if space and time is available. Late fee cheques should be made payable to the "Mission Marlins". Please give any late fee cheques to Shelley Diewold by 8:00 a.m. on the day of their event.
- Overnight:** The western-most area of the parking lot (closest to the Grand St. entrance and the high school) will be cordoned off for overnight vehicles. Please supply your own power. Tenting will be allowed in the enclosed baseball diamond across from the R.V.'s. Please do not set up tents near the water park. Leisure Centre toilets near the water park will be accessible for most of the day and a portable toilet will be placed within the cordoned off parking area for nighttime use. Pool showers will be available most of the day; a sign will be clearly posted to announce when showers are to be closed.
- Security:** This year the policy will continue to be **CAMP AT YOUR OWN RISK!** Do not leave any valuables unattended. The local RCMP Detachment will be alerted to the presence of swim meet camping at the Leisure Centre.
- O-Cat Swimmers:** While winter swimmers may only compete in "O-Cat" events, every effort will be made to have "O" swimmers placed in heats alongside age appropriate "S" swimmers. At the time this document is being produced, there is no guarantee that this is possible using the new timing system. Relay teams may contain one "O" swimmer per team.
- Combining Events:** We will be attempting to combine male and female events past Division 4 to make the swim meet run more efficiently. We will try to print up a meet package that accurately shows where people will be swimming however we will inform the coaches at the coaches meeting of any revisions to the program for combining events.

- Relays:** Each club may enter two relay teams per event. **Composition of relay teams must be reported by 10 am each day.** Swimmers may only swim “up” a maximum of two division levels when swimming relays; an exception is the Div 8 relay which is open to all swimmers provided that at least one Div 8 swimmer is a member of the relay team. (One “O” swimmer max. still applies).
- Rules:** All BCSSA rules will apply. No DQ’s for 6 & Under events. No false start rule is in effect.
- Jewelry:** Tightly fitting “Swim Strong” bands will be permitted at the swimmer’s own risk as well as ear or nose studs. **No hoops or chains will be allowed. However, any jewelry being worn will be at the discretion of the Session Referee.**
- Scoring:** Individual events: 1st through 12th place:
14,12,11,10,9,8,7,5,4,3,2,1 points
(6 & Unders do not receive individual or team points unless competing as a Division 1 competitor).
Relays: 1st through 6th place: 28,24,22,20,18,16 points
- Awards:** 1st to 12th place ribbons in individual events; 1st to 6th in relays. 6 & Unders receive goodie bags and participation ribbons. Aggregate winners and runners-up in each division that has 6 or more swimmers will be awarded.
- Officials:** Each club will be expected to fill a **MINIMUM** of two to three senior deck official positions per shift for both days. The Fraser Valley Regional Director of Officials will provide a schedule in advance, with each club’s responsibility for deck officials. It is the responsibility of each Club’s director of Officials to provide the name of the working official to take the designated position on the roster by the start of the officials meeting each day. Officials please attend the meeting at 7:30 a.m. both days. Deck officials and what we used to call “Timers & Recorders” should expect to work the duration of each stroke. Please designate club members in advance to be responsible for your designated lane. The Deck Officials “sign-up board” will be posted near the announcer’s table early both days. Please have your club members filled in by 8:00 a.m. each morning.
Abbotsford will staff two lanes, **Haney, Langley, Agassiz,** and **Chilliwack** will each staff one lane. Three positions per lane are required.
Mission parents will help to fill vacant positions when required.

Viewing: Spectators are required to view the races from the bleachers or in the enclosed space located opposite the bleachers and nearest to the Marshalling Area. Fire Access lanes must be kept open. Only those parents/ older siblings/ grandparents/ coaches etc. who are accompanying 6 & Under swimmers will be allowed near the Marshalling Area.

Marshalling Area: The deck is to be kept free of spectators, including swimmers who are not currently competing. An exception to this rule is that swimmers may approach their coach directly before or after their race. There will be two calls per event over the loudspeaker system. The final call will be announced as such. These are courtesy calls only. It is the sole responsibility of the swimmer to be at the marshalling table on time when they are called. There will be no individual calls for any event!

Day Camping: The management and staff of the Leisure Centre are adamant that there is to be no setup of “day camps” near the stairway and Marlins trophy case. This is due entirely to orders from the Fire Marshal that escape routes must be kept open. As a result, indoor day camps are to be set up within the curling rink and a sound system will be provided to alert swimmers to the calls to marshalling. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to report on time to marshalling regardless of these inconvenient circumstances. Any outdoor campers or those swimmers playing in the water park will also be expected to be alert to calls to Marshalling.

We are all looking forward to a great weekend and the start of our summer swimming season. Good luck to all of the participants!
