Both meetings will take place in front of the Announcers desk.

Heats: 8:00 a.m. Sat. & Sun.

Finals: Will be after the Heats and before Relays.

SCRATCHES: There will **not** be a scratch meeting. Scratches may be e-mailed to kamirault@shaw.ca up until **9:00 p.m. Monday, July 7th, 2008**. All other scratches should be handed in to the Clerk of the Course no later than 7:45 am on the day of the event.

ENTRIES: Swimmers may enter 4 individual events and swim on 2 relays. The deadline for entries is **Monday, July 7th at 5PM** Please submit your entries via e-mail to **Kim Amirault. E-mail to: kamirault@shaw.ca** or give them to our Head Coach **Gregg Gleason** at the Langley Meet on July 5/6th, 2008.

Please enclose your Validation list and the name and number of the person in charge of your entries in case of errors. If mailing a disk please ensure we get it by Tuesday July 8th. E-mail format preferred.

DECK ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED. SWITCHING OF EVENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED THIS YEAR. Deck entries must be in by 7:30AM. Therefore, it is crucial that Meet Entries and Validation List is correct and updated before submitting them.

FEES: Fraser Valley Clubs, reciprocal agreement in effect. **A \$5.00 per swimmer per day for deck entries for all FV clubs.**

OUT OF REGION FEES: These will be \$5.00 per event. Relay fee is \$5.00 per team per race. The maximum cost per swimmer is not to exceed \$20.00. Please

submit your cheques with your entries payable to **Agassiz-Harrison Aquanauts Swim Club**. There will be **NO REFUNDS** for scratched swimmers on the day of the event. Only 6 & Under swimmers registered with their home clubs may race and **do not** have to pay an entry fee.

RULES: PLEASE ASK THE COACHES TO KEEP THEMSELVES AND THEIR SWIMMERS OFF THE DECK IN FRONT OF THE BLEACHERS. SWIMMERS MAY CONFER WITH THEIR COACHES FROM OTHER SIDE OF FENCED AREA OR UNDER THE COACHES TENT.

BCSSA rules apply.

The meet will be an **open** format with the fastest 6 swimmers swimming in a championship final and the next 6 fastest swimmers swimming in a consolation final.

THERE WILL BE DECLARED FINALS if an event has 6 or less swimmers.

All swimmers must check in, in person, at the clerk of the course. ***It remains the responsibility of the swimmer to be aware of any changes to the status of their events.***

In order to swim in finals, all swimmers must check in with the Clerk of the Course and be ready to swim when their event is called. There will be no individual calls. Alternates should report when the event is called. If a swimmer has not reported after the third call, and an alternate has been called, the original swimmer and any previously called alternate are deemed irrevocably scratched from that event.

Note: Marshalling will not be required for Divisions 4 and up. Swimmers will be responsible for reporting to their events.

RELAYS: No more than 1 “O” swimmer on each relay team. Swimmers may swim on a relay team of a higher division. Relays will be swum as timed finals.

Relay team lists must be written on the back of the entry card and handed in to the Clerk of Course by 10:00 am each morning.

“O” SWIMMERS: Please enter your “O” swimmer in the appropriate category, (i.e. Cat 1 or 2.) “O” swimmers will swim with their appropriate “S” swimming age group.

POINTS: Scoring for all individual events will be: 14, 12, 11, 10, 9, 8; 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1; relay events will be: 14, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2.

There will be no points or place ribbons awarded to swimmers in the 6&U events. Instead they'll receive goodie bags and participation ribbons and their times will be posted.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded to the first 12 places for each individual swim. As well as for each relay. Individual aggregate winners and runners-up

will be given keeper awards. Depending on their numbers, Divisions 7 and 8 may be combined as a single event. Please be aware that ribbons and awards may not be available until Saturday, July 19th at the Abbotsford meet.

FACILITIES: The Ferny Coombe Pool is an outdoor pool that is 25 metres in length with 6 swimming lanes.

The local Lion's Club will again be operating the concession. Camping is available in **DESIGNATED AREAS with a \$10 fee**. Washrooms in the Agricultural Hall will be open during the day, and the Fitness Centre nearby has showers available for a fee. Washrooms in the Livestock Pavilion will be open 24 hours a day. In the past these washrooms have been poorly cared for by campers and may close if that trend continues.

All participants are reminded that the Agassiz Recreational Fairgrounds is a public facility and the consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited. Open flame camp fires are not allowed on the Fairgrounds.

NOTE: The PA system will not operate until 8:00 a.m. as a courtesy to the neighbouring residents. Marshalling will begin at approx. 8:00 a.m. **Please inform your swimmers at warm-ups so that they are aware and proceed to marshalling by 7:50 a.m. for the first events.**

OFFICIALS: In order for the meet to run efficiently and finish at a reasonable hour, we request that all clubs provide as many individuals to work as deck officials. A sign up board will be on deck for all parents willing to help out. Clubs with more than 50 participating swimmers will be required to supply extra help for each shift. Cooperation ensures an enjoyable meet for everyone!
