



**MISSION MARLINS SWIM CLUB
INVITATIONAL OPEN MEET
MAY 26/ 27, 2007**

Meet Manager: Phil Van der Veen (604-820-0742); missionmarlins@shaw.ca

Location: Mission Leisure Centre, 7650 Grand St. (at 7th Avenue)

Entrance is opposite the high school. The pool is a 6 lane, 25 meter facility. A food concession is on site as well as a sports shop which sells a limited supply of swim gear. Water park will be open, weather permitting.

Type of Meet: "Open" Meet format (no A/ B cutoff); timed finals; competitors may enter a maximum of 6 individual events and 2 relays. **Meet Registrars:** please ensure that swimmers in Div 5 and higher register for only six (6) of the seven (7) available individual events. Heats will be run from slowest to fastest so it is important that swimmers be registered with their fastest times. Please make efforts to time all swimmers who do not possess official times; as a last resort estimate the swimmers times. **NOTE:** please ensure that all swimmers have been placed in their proper Division by BCSSA.

Entry Fees: There are no entry fees this year.

Overnight Parking& Tenting: The western-most area of the parking lot (closest to the Grand St. entrance and the high school) will be cordoned off for overnight vehicles. Please supply your own power. Tenting will be allowed in the enclosed baseball diamond across from the R.V.'s. Please do not set up tents near the water park. Leisure Centre toilets near the water park will be accessible for most of the day and a portable toilet will be placed within the cordoned off parking

area for nighttime use. Pool showers will be available most of the day; a sign will be clearly posted to announce when showers are to be closed.

Security: The contracting of a security firm last year to oversee site security was not a success. Therefore, this year a policy of **CAMP AT YOUR OWN RISK** is being adopted. Do not leave any valuables unattended. The local RCMP detachment will be alerted to the presence of swim meet camping at the Leisure Centre.

Winter swimmers: While winter swimmers may only compete in “O-cat” events, every effort will be made to have “O” swimmers placed in heats alongside age appropriate “S” swimmers. At the time this document is being produced, there is no guarantee that this is possible using the new timing system. Relay teams may contain one “O” swimmer per team.

Relays: Each club may enter two relay teams per event. **Composition of relay teams must be reported by 10 am each day.** Swimmers may only swim “up” a maximum of two division levels when swimming relays; an exception is the Div 8 relay which is open to all swimmers provided that at least one Div 8 swimmer is a member of the relay team. (one “O” swimmer max still applies)

Rules: All BCSSA rules will apply. No DQ’s for 6 & Under events. No false start rule is in effect.

Jewelry: tightly fitting “Swim Strong” bands will be permitted around the wrists and/ or ankles as will ear or nose studs. No hoops or chains will be allowed.

Scoring: Individual events: 1st through 12th place: 14,12,11,10,9,8,7,5,4,3,2,1 points (6 & Unders do not receive individual or team points unless competing as Div.1 competitor)

Relays: 1st through 6th place: 28,24,22,20,18,16 points

Awards: 1st to 12th place ribbons in individual events; 1st to 6th in relays. 6 & Unders receive goodie bags and participation ribbons. Aggregate winners and runners-up in each division will receive a medal.

Officials: Each club will be expected to fill a **MINIMUM** of two senior deck official positions throughout the meet, more if they send a large contingent of

swimmers. Deck officials and what we used to call “Timers & Recorders” (we are planning to use two plungers plus a back-up stopwatch for each lane) should expect to work the duration of each stroke.

Plungers: **Abbotsford** will staff two lanes, **Haney** and **Langley** one lane + stopwatch each plus a shared lane, **Chilliwack** and **Agassiz** will share a lane
(3 positions): assignment. **Mission** parents will help to fill vacant positions when required.

Viewing: Spectators are required to view the races from the bleachers or in the enclosed space located opposite the bleachers and nearest to the Marshalling Area. Fire Access lanes must be kept open. Only those parents/ older siblings/ grandparents/ coaches etc. who are accompanying U-6 swimmers (or those older swimmers new to swim meets) will be allowed in the **Marshalling Area**. The deck is to be kept free of spectators, including swimmers who are not in competition. An exception to this rule is that swimmers may approach their coach directly before or after their race.

“Day Camping”: The management and staff of the Leisure Centre are adamant that there is to be no setup of “day camps” near the stairway and Marlins trophy case as occurred in 2006. This is due entirely to orders from the Fire Marshal that escape routes be kept open. As a result, indoor day camps are to be set up within the curling rink and a sound system will be provided to alert swimmers to the calls to marshalling. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to report on time to marshalling regardless of these inconvenient circumstances. Any outdoor campers or those swimmers playing in the water park will also be expected to be alert to calls to Marshalling.
