**SCRATCHES** – Scratches must be submitted to the Clerk Of The Course by 8:00 am on Saturday. There will be no refunds for missed or scratched events.

Swimmers may enter a maximum of 4 individual events (plus 2 relays).

You will notice that events are numbered “101B”, “101C”, etc. Swimmers are to be entered into the “B” and “C” events according to the eligibility rules laid out in the Meet Package.

## EVENT ORDER

Event order please see attached.

Added novice events need to be submitted to the Clerk of the Course before the meet begins on Sat AM.

## ELIGIBILITY

All swimmers must be currently registered with the Vancouver Island Region of the BCSSA. To swim in the B & C Championship meet the swimmer must have swum in the event at least once after May 1<sup>st</sup> 2010. First year swimmers who have never competed in a BCSSA swim meet are an exception and may enter events. These new swimmers must be entered in the "C" category of each event they enter.

The swimmer shall not have achieved an "A" time in the event they are entering. These times are in accordance with the current 2010 Vancouver Island Cut-off times. A swimmer who has a best time for an event that is slower than the "A" time but faster than the "B" time indicated of the Cut-off table should be entered and swim as a "B" swimmer in that event. Swimmers who have not yet achieved the "B" cut-off time for an event should be entered and swim in that event as a "C" swimmer. It is very important that swimmers be entered correctly into an event in the appropriate "B" or "C" meet category.

The "C" meet is open to all first year swimmers who have never competed in a BCSSA/SNC swim meet, to any swimmer with a valid "C" time, or a swimmer who is competing in their first 50m event in a particular stroke or first 100IM.

"O" swimmers are also eligible to enter this meet. "O" swimmers must use the equivalent "S" category cut-off times for their age group (division)

Swimmers will not change designation in the course of the meet. Coaches will be allowed to check qualifications of "B" and "C" swimmers with the appropriate protest filed at the meet should the need arise. Swimmers that achieve an "A" time in heats or finals, regardless of how much faster over the "A" time will not be disqualified. Only entry requirements are important. The results of awards will be based on the "B" or "C" meet category entered, regardless of time achieved.

**Novice** : There will be 4 novice events, 25m of Free, Back, Breast and Fly. A Novice swimmer is swimming a 25-meter event to gain swimming experience. A Novice swimmer will not be disqualified, will not receive an official time, and will not be entered on official results, but may be awarded a participant award.

Novice designation is stroke specific. (i.e. A swimmer may be Novice in Butterfly but not in Freestyle.)

Novice swimmers can not compete in a relay if they require assistance.

Once a swimmer has swum 50m in a specific stroke, in an individual event or in a relay, they are no longer Novice in that stroke.

Once a swimmer achieves a time under 30 seconds for 25m, they are no longer Novice in that stroke.

Swimming in a Novice Event does not qualify the swimmer for the Regional Championships.

**Relays** : Relay teams will be seeded in their appropriate Division regardless of the number of "O" swimmers on the team. If more than one "O" swimmer is on a relay team, that relay will be treated as an "O" Cat relay in the final results. **Relays will be timed finals.**

The Regional registrar may check the relay entries to ensure swimmer eligibility. Relays may contain any combination of "B" or "C" swimmers. Swimmers may not swim a stroke in a relay if they obtained a 50m "A" time in that stroke in a meet previous to this Championship meet. If there are not enough swimmers with "B" or "C" times to form a Freestyle relay team, a swimmer with an "A" time may swim on the relay but he/she must swim a stroke in which he/she has not achieved an "A" time in prior to this meet. If this situation should arise, the coach is required to notify CV Blue Devils in the email entry for permission. Stroke and Turn officials will appropriately judge the stroke and all the rules of that stroke must be adhered to.

Relays will be swum as a timed final even if there are more than 6 teams entered. The relays will be swum following the preliminary heats and before the novice events.

**Entries :** Swimmers must be entered with their best times using Hy-Tek Team Manager. Times must have been achieved after May 01, 2010. **Swimmers who have an A time in an event cannot compete in that event.**

Please indicate brand new swimmers that are being entered as “C” swimmers. These swimmers do not need proof of swimming in a qualifying meet after May1, 2010. Please enter these swimmers with a NT.

Disabled Swimmers : Coaches are to notify the meet manager at the beginning of the meet of any swimmers with disabilities. Swimmers must attempt to do the proper stroke. Disability must be a recorded medical problem certified by a Physician.

### **FEES**

Cheques for Meet Fees, Deck Food, and T Shirts must be given to the Clerk Of The Course, no later than 10:00 am on Sunday. Please make all cheques payable to Courtenay Blue Devils Swim Club.

### **CONDUCT**

The Deck area is for swimmers, officials, and coaches. All others are asked not to use the deck as a shortcut to their destination.

No glass containers are permitted in the pool deck areas.

Please obey all rules of the pool

### **FINALS**

Finals will be held for all “B”, “C”, and “O” swimmers.  
These events may be combined.

“B” Championship (Individual) 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> (Medals) 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> (Ribbons)  
“C” Championship (Individual) 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> (Medals) 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> (Ribbons)  
“B” and “C” Relays (combined) 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> (Medals) 3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> (Ribbons)  
“O” Individual or Relays as per the “S” events

### **OFFICIALS**

All clubs are asked to please provide as much support as possible for all deck positions. Clubs are responsible to provide timers for their designated lanes. This will be sent out after all entries are completed.

### **ISLAND CLUB PARTICIPATION**

As this is an Island Regional meet, Island clubs will be expected to provide deck officials, timers, recorders, & place judges. Clubs will also be required to assist with deck food preparation and distribution (See Deck Food). The timing sign up schedule will be distributed via email, prior to the event. Please make sure your club is accountable for their positions to ensure the meet runs smoothly and effectively. Thank you in advance for your generosity in signing up. The success and the timeliness of the meet depends on us all.

## **DECK FOOD**

All participating teams will be asked to assist with the purchase and serving of deck food. Each team with 40 or more swimmers is asked to contribute \$75.00 towards the purchase of Deck Food. Clubs with less than 40 swimmers are asked to pay \$37.50. The CV Blue Devils Deck Food committee will purchase the food for the event.

### **Concession:**

Will be open from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm on both days

**VEHICLE PARKING:** We realize that parking very near the pool facility fills up quickly. **Do not park in front of the pool facility emergency vehicle access gate**, it will be clearly marked. **Please be considerate of the local businesses and do not park in their private areas. We get a few complaints every year.** Parking is available in the nearby adjacent parks. Parking will also be available on a vacant lot just north of the pool on the right hand side just before Sunwest Volkswagen. Your cooperation in this matter would be greatly appreciated.

**WATER PARK:** Please note that tents are **not permitted** in the water park area. Tents may be erected during the day only on the grass in the park on the west side of the pool. A notice will be posted in the marshalling area to ask the kids to please make sure they brush any sand or dirt off themselves before entering the marshalling area to prevent dirt and sand from getting in the pool and clogging the filter

Coaches will be provided with a light refreshment and water. ***They are responsible for their own lunches and snacks***
